The article describes the history of developing the application Dictionary System, and the methods of programming and creating a lexicographic tool for compiling dictionaries and encyclopaedias. This system was used to create the Icelandic-Czech Students' Dictionary.

As usually, our publication finishes with the appendix that deals with the possibilities and tasks of the Ph.D. students of Information Technologies in Education at the ICT Department of the Pedagogical Faculty of University of Ostrava. The Ph.D. studies are connected with the offer introduced in the title of this editorial. We believe this periodical is aproper publication platform for Ph.D. students, who are required to publish during their studies anyway.
